Level of Isolation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer may be alone with the person in needs of services. 		
Level of Supervision	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer has limited or no supervision. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The services rendered to the person in need takes place in a closed area or where there is no supervision. 		
Access to the property	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer has access to personal belongings or finances of the person in need of services. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer has access to personal or confidential information about the person in need of services. 		
Level of Physical Contact	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The job description specifies the level of physical contact required with the person in need of services. 		
Vulnerability of the people receiving services	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person(s) in need of services has (have) a linguistic barrier (language, non-literate). 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person(s) in need of services has (have) limited or non existing mobility. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The person(s) in need of services has (have) disabilities which may affect their vulnerability (physical, psychological, emotional or situational handicaps). 		
Level of Physical Activity	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The activity presents a potential danger for the person in need of services (climbing, use of stove). 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The activity presents a potential stress (children bothered by visits to residences or group homes, or activities of a support group). 		
Level of Trust	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer develops a close or personal relationship with the person in need of services. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The job description includes the transportation of those people in need of services. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The responsible person/volunteer partakes in the making of important decisions of the people in need of services. 		
Level of Inherent Risk	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The level of risk rises when the responsible person/volunteer comes in contact with bodily fluid or physical manifestations the illness of the person in need of services. 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The activity exposes the person in need of services to the use or manipulation of equipment that may be dangerous (lawn mower). 		
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The activity exposes the person in need of services to dangerous substances, poor air quality, excessive noise, etc. (A mission of demolition work in a less fortunate neighborhood).
